MAESYDRE PLAYGROUND

The group looked around the park and noticed that the grass had been cut since the last visit by Cllr Bennett.

There were 2 pieces of equipment in the play area, which were dilapidated. One was a see-saw and the other a slide which a resident of a neighbouring property told us had been declared unsafe by PCC some years ago. (Photos attached)

The ground matting was very uneven and had pot holes in. A child on a scooter fell over quite heavily whilst we were in the Park.

Councillors agreed that a site meeting must take place with a representative of PCC as soon as possible.
