- 484/05 TO DISCUSS REFURBISHMENT OF CHAIRS IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER. Councillors thanked Cllr Bennett for liaising with Hafren Furnishers. It was agreed after looking at the sample chair, that another 5 Chairs (making it 6 in total) would be refurbished this year. The total spend would be £480.00.
- 484/06 TO RECEIVE AND DISCUSS ANNUAL RETURN (ratified at the last meeting) AND THE INTERNAL AUDIT REPORT AND AGREE ON FOLLOW-UP ACTIONS Cllr Hughes read out the conclusion of the Internal Audit Report and explained the report and actions plan. The action plan as attached, was unanimously agreed.
- 484/07 TO DISCUSS PROPOSED LIFT FOR THE TOWN HALL Cllr Hughes explained that the plans were reviewed last year and at the July 2022 Council meeting, it was agreed that an estimate from the Architect for obtaining planning and listed building permission would be sought. The Architect would charge £1,250 + £460 (to PCC) in total £1,750. Cllr J Jones stated that he would be happy if the funding for the lift, a total of approx. £80,000 was in place first. Cllr Hughes and the committee will investigate funding opportunities through PAVO before any further work takes place. Cllr McArthur stated that as technology has improved, the cost of the lift may have reduced.
- 484/08 TO DISCUSS PROPOSED CLOSURE OF AIR AMBULANCE BASE AT WELSHPOOL Cllr J Jones explained that he understood the closure is not down to cost savings but due to efficiency. It was agreed to invite the trustees of Wales Air Ambulance to come to Llanidloes to meet with town council.
- 484/09 TO RECEIVE INFORMATION/UPDATES FROM COUNTY COUNCILLORS G. MORGAN AND G. PRESTON Councillors discussed the new housing development,

Clos yr Hen Ysgol, which they visited last week and stated how impressive it is being quite a success story for PCC. Cllr Preston informed Council that the Council houses in Caegwyn are now being renovated after a long delay. Cllr Morgan informed Council that he is dealing with the closure of the road from Short Bridge Street to Chapel Street and is obtaining signatures for a petition. Cllr Bennett asked if the weeds growing in gutters around the long bridge could be reported to PCC

- 484/10 TO RECEIVE E MAIL FROM MR VICTOR LLOYD AND TO DISCUSS ANY DEVELOPMENTS AT CWMDU It was agreed that a site visit is required to keep all Councillors updated on the problems, this will take place at 6pm on Monday 10th October.
- 484/11 TO RECEIVE LETTER FROM PCC REGARDING NAMING A NEW HOUSING DEVELOPMENT It was unanimously agreed that Swn yr Afon will be suitable.
- 484/12 TO RECEIVE INFORMATION FROM PCC REGARDING GLASS AND PAPER RECYCLING BANKS TO BE REMOVED FROM COMMUNITY RECYCLING SITES It was agreed that this will not affect us as we only have Clothing and Cardboard recycling on the Gro.
- 484/13 TO DISCUSS BRYNPOSTEG ISSUES Councillors were informed that Brynposteg is currently accepting waste to fill up an active cell. The operator is permitted to do so until the void is filled. However, Clerk informed Council that after speaking to the site manager, there will be a planning application in the near future for an extension of the site.
- 484/14 TO RECEIVE PRESENTATION FROM MRS CLARE BOUND, TRUSTEE OF LLANIDLOES FOOD BANK Mrs Bound was invited to explain to Council the way in which the food bank works. She thanked Council for providing Toilet Rolls and helping out with photocopying etc especially during Covid lockdown. She explained that there are more people using the food bank now and donations from the public are getting less. 2 grants have been received from PCC. Mrs Bound asked if Council would consider getting involved in a group which could bring organisations together to come up with plans during the fuel crisis. The purchase of Air Fryers was discussed. Councillors unanimously agreed to get involved and it was agreed to hold the initial meeting of a Cost of Living Task Force on 10th October at 6.30 pm
- 484/15 TO DISCUSS PLANS FOR REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY Clerk informed Council that she has a meeting next week with the RBL Ladies to discuss plans for Remembrance Sunday. Cllr Bennett as Chair of Environment will also attend the meeting. Clerk has recently spoken to Rev Alison Gwalchmai and she is keen to hold a Church service this year and then meet at the Cenotaph after the service. It was unanimously agreed that the service at the Cenotaph should take place at 11.00 am to make it inclusive for all. Clerk will report back to the next meeting with final plans
